## "Dit" names

Since there were very few surnames in French Canada, various family lines with the same surname adopted nicknames or aliases to differentiate themselves from each other. These aliases were called "dit" names.

Some dit names were based on physical features, occupations or places. Later, some of these dit names became the surnames of the various family lines.

"Dit" is properly pronounced "dee"; in the case of a woman's alias, it becomes "dite" pronounced "deet". Hence, it is Pierre Laperche dit St. Jean; and Marie Laperche dite St. Jean.

Since place names themselves were often based on geographical features, as well as flora and fauna, many dit names are literally translatable:

Boismenu = little forest

LeGrand = the tall man

Deslormes = of the elms

Boulangier = baker

Charpentier = carpenter

Roy, Roi, Leroy = king

Dupont = of the bridge

L'Ours = the bear

Whether surname or dit name, all suffered the consequences of a low literacy rate, and heavy dependency on phonetic spelling by those who were literate. Spelling variations were rampant, especially as the French moved from Canada into what is now the United States. When other nationalities followed, still more variations arose as one group tried to cope with the totally unfamiliar names of another.

Whether the original surname or the dit name survived seemed to follow no apparent pattern. In the case of the original MONET family from France, it soon became Monet dit Boismenu in Canada, then quickly became Boismenu - at least in the line settling in the Cahokia, IL area. Boismenu is the name that survives to this day in this branch, and Monet has disappeared entirely.

In the case of the LAPERCHE family, for a few generations it became Laperche dit St. Jean, reverted to simply Laperche which still survives while St. Jean vanished from this line.

Other original surnames - especially common ones such as Roy or Martin, and in families with large numbers of descendants early in history of Canada - amassed several dit names out of sheer necessity. No doubt many of these dit names still survive.
