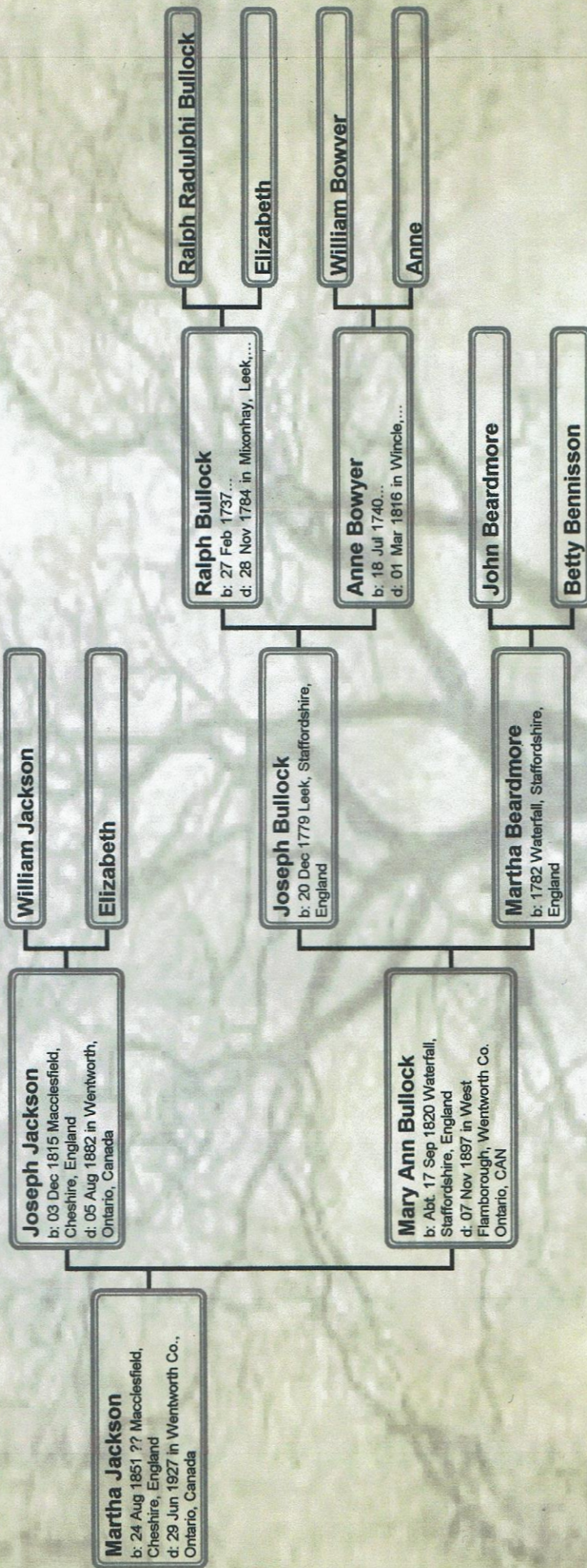

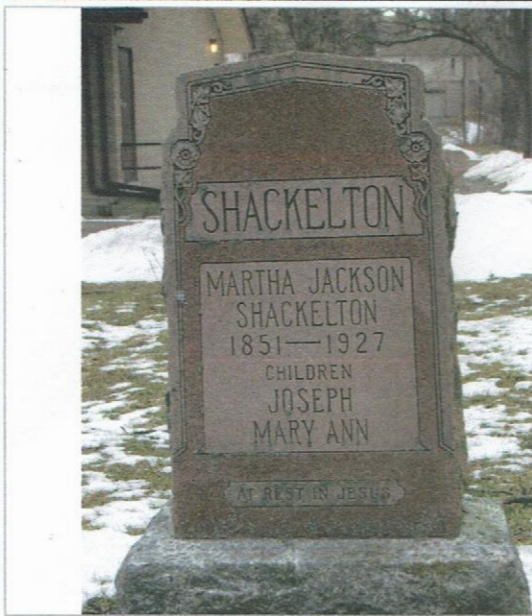

THE BULLOCKS OF BULLOCK'S CORNERS

Bullock's Corners was named after William Bullock, the elder. He was born in Staffordshire, England, on October 5th, 1804. He migrated to Pennsylvania, moved with his wife, Anne, and one son, William, the younger, to Upper Canada in 1833. He owned property on John Street in Hamilton, near where the Post Office stands to-day. In 1837 he purchased from Captain Peter Hunter Hamilton, the patentee, one-half acre of land in Lot 10, Concession 2, and built a hotel, which he called the British House and which became the nucleus of the community which grew up around it.

On the 10th of February, 1841, he purchased additional land at the Corners, part of Lot 10, Concession 2, which contained land on both sides of the Stream, from Kirby's water rights on the north where the stone bridge crosses the Stream, to the Webster water rights on the south, on a line with the road entering Webster Falls Park. He built a grist and saw mill, the ruins remain, the Clark Blanket Co. ruins at the Corners; a large block of stores where Maxwell Walker's Garage stands north to the end of W. Rice's barn; also several dwelling houses for his employees along the stream to Kerby's Bridge.

In 1840 he purchased Lot 10 in the 4th Concession and in 1841 built a hotel, which he called the Prince Albert, apparently after the Consort of Queen Victoria, Prince Albert of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha, this he operated under lease to several tenants, but records divulge that an old competitor at the Corners, Frances Cochenour, had leased it and was personally operating it in 1861.

In 1861, the sons, William and Joseph, had moved the steam equipment from the mills at Bullock's Corners to the 4th Concession property and were operating lumber yards and mills, bringing in timber from the northern parts of the Township and properties north in Wellington, Simcoe and Muskoka Counties.

In 1841, William and a recently arrived brother Ralph, purchased part of Lot 7, Concession 6, and built a hotel, which Ralph operated for some years, selling it to William McMann, who leased it to Fred Leach in 1861. It was still an inn in 1876 and leased by Thos. Hunter.

In 1855, William Bullock, the elder, purchased Lot 9, Concession 6—two hundred acres for £600; the same year he purchased Lot 14, Concession 6—two hundred acres for £600; the same year Lot 15, Concession 6—two hundred acres for £600; still in 1855, Lot 3, Concession 7—two hundred acres £600. In 1875 Jos. Bullock resided on Lot 9, Concession 6, but shortly after he left for St. John, N.B., with the Standard Oil of New Jersey. He left a large estate there. His son, John, was Mayor of St. John, N.B., for several years. John and George Bullock occupied Lot 3, Concession 7, until George was killed by accident in 1900 and John left the farm in 1918. It is now in the possession of Jas. Smith of the 7th Concession.

In 1848, William, the elder, with Dr. Jas. Hamilton, was on the District Council and purchased property for the erection of a school on Lot 11, Concession 2. He entered the Municipal Council in 1852-53-54-55, was Deputy Reeve for the years 1854-55. He retired from business in 1856 and turned his properties and business over to his two sons, William and Joseph. He died in 1866 and was the first burial in Christ Church Cemetery at the Corners.

In 1871, the Clark brothers purchased the mill property at the Corners. Kenneth Wishart and Wm. VanEvery purchased the store property and houses on the west side of the stream. In 1862 the British Hotel was sold to Michael Lyons.

The Bullocks have disappeared from the Corners. William, the younger, died in 1912; a son, William, died in 1936. John, who resided for some years on the 7th Concession, died in 1944. A son, William J., of Birmingham, Ala., is a successful manufacturer there of non-ferrous metals; a son of his, William, also lives in Birmingham. Thos. Bullock, a son of John, a veteran of World War I, resides in Hamilton, as does also a sister Jessie. The Bullock home at the Corners is now owned by Howard Clark. The hotel property is owned by Glen Taylor.

THE JACKSONS

Records show that Joseph Jackson left Garston, a suburb of Liverpool, in the fall of 1853. He had been urged by his brother-in-law, Wm. Bullock, to come to Canada and care for the mills of the Bullocks, Jackson being a millwright. Mary Ann Bullock Jackson, a sister of the founder of Bullock's Corners, was recognized for her unique ability to care for the sick and particularly for the prospects of small ones. Old timers have shown their scars proudly and explained that Granny Jackson had scratched the scar, and drawn from her bottle of scabs the antidote against the feared plague and if there was a whimper all the sympathy extended was "Dinna ye blather or I'll clout thy lugs." Of the family born in Canada Matthew located at the Corners, he died in 1908, his son, Gordon, remains, the last of the old families and the last of the Bullock blood.
