A. **Deborah Vallis** #658 b. ____ 1799,¹ m. ____ 1822,² **John Bingley Garland** #162, b. 29 Nov 1791, Poole, England,² (son of George Garland #151 and Amy Lester #152) ref.,³ d. 12 Jun 1875, Stone Park, Wimborne, England, buried: Garland Memorial Chapel, Poole. Deborah died 3 Jul 1839, France.⁴ **John**: Carried on an extensive business at Trinity. Elected first member for Trinity District in 1832 when Nfld. granted representative government. First speaker of the House of Assembly 1833. Mayor of Poole, England, 1824. Lived the life of a country gentleman at Lesson House & Stone. Was high sheriff of Dorset in 1827. Oldest magistrate in the country. ref: various, incl. MOSD, RIGGS
