The following summarizes the status of standing committee actions and activities for the last 12 months:

• Sharing of Course Material:

Development continues on distance learning material related to CANDU. A trial version of the CANDU OVERVIEW course given in Thailand has been put on CD-ROM and is currently under review and testing.

University Course Sharing

The possibility of a reciprocal course credit agreement between RMC and McMaster is currently being investigated. The committee awaits word from RMC.

• Student Conference:

The 1999 conference was held at Trent University, hosted by Jim Jury, Department of Physics. There was a tour of Canadian General Electric's nuclear fuel fabrication facility. The quality of the student presentations was very high but the attendance was very low. Revitalizing this conference is a high priority item for this committee and suggestions are welcome. The next conference will be held at McMaster University in the spring of 2000, hosted by yours truly.
